Board of Fire Commissioners Regular Meeting Minutes Fire Station One 333 West Nebraska Street – Frankfort, IL 60423 Tuesday, March 9, 2021 – 10:00 A.M.

I. CALL TO ORDER:

The President called the meeting to order at 10:14 A.M.

II. ROLL CALL:

Donna Vegter Michael Minogue

DC Sean Fierce and AC Paul Kinsella were also in attendance.

III. PUBLIC COMMENTS:

None.

IV. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES:

President Garritano requested the Secretary to call the roll for the vote. Upon the roll being called, the following Commissioners voted:

The President declared the Motion carried.

V. CHIEFS REPORT:

DC Fierce and AC Kinsella provided the following information:

- Six (6) candidates were hired one (1) month ago and have been on shift for the past two and onehalf (2-1/2) weeks;
- The hiring of personnel was part of the new Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA), as well as the formation of "BC Actors";

V. CHIEFS REPORT: [Continued]

- By having the BC Actors, the hiring pool of Lieutenants and Engineers expands, and allows the Chiefs to draw from this pool for absences, when necessary, and/or reduce overtime expense;
- Two (2) new hires are assigned per shift and spend about one-third (1/3) of a year at Stations 72, 73 and 75. New hires are not assigned to Station 71 because the Technical Squads (Dive Team, TRT & CART) are on duty there;
- In reference to the BC Actors
 - o Seven (7) Lieutenants are "shadowing" the BCs for six (6) shifts;
 - o They are introduced to the day-to-day working operations;
 - o Their decisions are monitored by the BC of the day;
 - o Enables the BC Actors to prepare for BC testing in the future; and,
 - o Program working out well and has received positive feed-back.

VI. UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. Engineer Promotional Process (Update)

DC Fierce and AC Kinsella provided the following information:

- The Union had filed a grievance on behalf of a member due to the fact he took the written portion of the Engineer's test while he had Covid-19 side-affects, and as a result, did not pass the test;
- The Board of Trustees denied the grievance and reached an agreement with the Union to have the member re-test;
- When re-tested, the member passed and per the Agreement, was placed at the bottom of the Engineer Eligibility List;
- A member who is currently on Military Leave is tentatively due back mid-April and will be offered the test;
- Following completion of the second member's test, "practicals" will be scheduled for both members; and,
- Once the final scores are computed, the Commissioners will schedule a meeting to adjust member placement on the Engineer Eligibility List.

The Commissioners held a brief discussion on Covid-19 and AC Kinsella provided the following information:

- A little over fifty-percent (50%) of the department has been vaccinated;
- A low number of members had Covid-19 no serious issues; and,
- Currently, in contact with the Health Department to assist with vaccinations in the area clinics, but due to the shortage of vaccine, nothing has been scheduled.

VII. NEW BUSINESS:

1. Battalion Chief Promotion Process

DC Fierce provided the following information:

- Distributed packets to the Commissioners outlining excerpts of new language in the CBA, the Battalion Chief job description and questions previously used during the interviews;
- Requested the Commissioners to review the packets and possibly update the interview questions;
- The Battalion Chief promotional process will start in a few months;
- Test books are being ordered and arranging to schedule a written test date with Resource Management;
- Anticipate posting an exam date by April 1, with the actual process beginning July-August;
- Foresee 8-9 candidates testing for the BC Eligibility List AC Kinsella is also interested in testing for the List, since his last "sworn" rank was Lieutenant; and,

VII. NEW BUSINESS: [Continued]

• The department currently has four (4) Battalion Chiefs (Campbell, Curtin, Hamm and Stukel), but only three (3) are active. Wally Curtin is in the process of a disability retirement.

DC Fierce advised the Commissioners that possible changes may be in the near future:

- Chief Wilson will attain his 5th year as being Fire Chief in June and has made comments that he may be contemplating retirement at some point;
- If that occurs, it is the Board of Trustees decision to either promote from within the department or hire from the outside;
- The new Chief has the option of retaining one or both of the current Chiefs (Deputy and Asst.) or choosing his/her own personnel;
- In the event the current Deputy and Asst. Chiefs are not chosen, they return to their respective prior "sworn" positions, i.e., Battalion Chief, Lieutenant or Engineer;
- Deputy Chief and Asst. Chief are appointed positions by the Fire Chief;
- In reference to the Board of Trustees, changes may also be possible within the next two (2) election cycles:
 - Trustee Kavanagh is retiring from Mokena Fire Prot. District July 2, 2021 and plans on moving to Tennessee;
 - o Trustee Rossi may resign if he is elected to the position of Frankfort Village Trustee in the upcoming election; and,
 - o Both Trustees Hoffmeister and Nice have ongoing health issues
